The Sunshine Coast Junior Eisteddfod is a Not for Profit organization that is funded entirely from entry fees, program sales, ticket sales, advertising, sponsorships and donations. We do not receive any council or government funding. Each year it costs \$40,000 to cover our costs which include hall hire and adjudicators fees. All committee members work on a volunteer basis.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Entry form and entry fee** including date of birth, together with entry fees are to be mailed to the appropriate music convenor. No date of birth – NO entry.
2. Competitor's age is the age the competitor becomes during the 2018 calendar year.
3. Names of competitors in Duets must be given at the time of entry in order for the entry to be accepted and processed correctly.
4. All Eisteddfod participants do so at their own risk.
5. The Adjudicator must not be addressed during the eisteddfod except via an eisteddfod official. All inquiries or requests are to be made to the convenor.
6. Payment may be made by:
Cheque - payable to - **Sunshine Coast Junior Eisteddfod Inc.**
Cash – hand delivered to appropriate convenor.
Direct Deposit – completing **every** step of the instruction sheet supplied to you in this Schedule.
7. For confirmation of receiving your entry, please include a stamped self-addressed envelope.
8. **Own Choice Copy for the Adjudicator** must be clearly marked with the required identification form which is to be attached to the top left hand corner of your copy. You will find these forms in this schedule. No responsibility is accepted by the Committee for music incorrectly labelled. **Own Choice copy** for the Adjudicator must reach the appropriate convenor by **Thursday 14th June 2018**.
9. **Copyright Declaration Form** must be completed for each entry. PDF file on website. One form per competitor to be completed and sent to convenor by **Thursday 14th June 2018**.
If you are entering different sections e.g. Piano and Strings you must complete a form for each section and send to the appropriate convenor.
10. **Time limits** must be observed. An item may be shorter than the limit but **NOT** exceed it. A penalty will be incurred.
11. **Withdrawals** – Competitors who do not intend to compete in an item for which they have entered, must notify the appropriate convenor before the time appointed for that particular item. Notification of withdrawal is regarded as **courtesy** to the Committee, fellow competitors, Adjudicators and patrons.
12. **Programs** will be on sale from our local Music Stores. The date the program is available will be announced on our website.

Programs cost \$6.00. If posted an additional fee of \$3.00 each will be required.

RIGHTS OF COMMITTEE

1. The Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry and refund fees, and to ask for proof of age.
2. **COMPETITORS MUST PERFORM FROM ORIGINAL MUSIC.** (If music is unavailable competitors **MUST** check with the appropriate convenor for any alteration to this rule).
3. **COMPETITORS MUST BE AMATEURS** (ones whose main source of income is not derived from the exercise of his/her talent), and must compete in their correct age sections. (not applicable to accompanists / conductors).
4. No competitor may enter or compete under any name other than his/her own name.
5. All competitors will be numbered and their order of appearance will be in the official program. Competitors must be ready to appear as soon as their number is called.
6. No teacher will be allowed on stage with a competitor for any item except as an accompanist or conductor.
7. **COMPETITORS MUST ARRANGE THEIR OWN ACCOMPANISTS.** (If unable to do so, contact the appropriate convenor for an accompanist – a fee will apply).
8. No prize will be awarded without sufficient merit. Adjudicators have the right to withhold or divide prizes according to merit.
9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any section should there be insufficient entries. All entrants affected will be notified after the closing date. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way and at any time. e.g. Items may be split or combined if warranted.
10. An adjudication sheet of each performance will be available for collection following the adjudication of each item at the appropriate venue door.
11. No protest against an awarded adjudication will be permitted unless it is proved that some error in identity has happened.
12. Protests must be made in writing and lodged with the appropriate convenor immediately after occurring and before adjudication, and accompanied by a fee of \$20.00 to be forfeited if the protest is deemed frivolous. The Committee's decision will be considered final.
13. Written complaints other than adjudication are to be lodged with the Committee within 30 days of the completion of the Eisteddfod.
14. If a competitor in a duet, trio, etc. is unable to perform due to unforeseen circumstances he/she may be replaced provided the appropriate convenor has been notified prior to the item.
15. Competitors may perform **ONCE** only in a duet, trio, quartet or choir item. Please refer to relevant sections for further details.
16. In small and large instrumental and vocal ensembles, competitors may perform **ONCE** only. When representing their school and a community ensemble, the competitor may perform in both.
17. No competitor may perform the same material more than once during the Eisteddfod.
18. One piece only to be performed per item unless confirmed in schedule. e.g. Championships, Large Ensembles.
19. Lost property will be kept for 2 weeks after Eisteddfod. If unclaimed it will be given to charity. Unclaimed Adjudicator's reports will be kept until the completion of the Eisteddfod.

GROUP MIME WITH MUSIC

The Mime can be either in the style of thematic, abstract or literal. Title and style of piece must be submitted to session convenor on a piece of paper along with session and competitor number before presenting. NO COSTUMES, MASKS OR PROPS. Music to be provided by competitors on the day on a device. Groups 3-6

10. Group Mime to Music 14 years & under Time Limit 4 mins. \$15.00

ORIGINAL CHARACTER RECITAL

One character only – costume optional. This recital is to be devised by the student/teacher/parent. It is an ORIGINAL character and therefore not found in an existing story, play or monologue. Be creative and original and have fun. Author to be acknowledged on copy. These characters are to be original.

11. Original Character Recital 10 years & under Time Limit 2 mins. \$6.00

SOLO IMPROVISATION

A scene using speech and action based on a theme given by the adjudicator. Warning Bell given at 3 minutes.

12. Solo Improvisation 14 – 18 years Time Limit 4 mins. \$6.00

GROUP IMPROVISATION

Group is required to devise a scene by creating speech and action based on a theme provided by the adjudicator. A balance of speech and action is required. A warning bell will be rung at the 3 minute mark. 3 – 8 players. No pre prepared work eligible.

13. Group Improvisation Secondary Age Students Time Limit 5 mins. \$15.00

DUOLOGUE

Own choice. Duologues MUST come from a PUBLISHED Play or adapted from a PUBLISHED Novel. Citation of source must be provided. Both names required for the program.

14. Duologue 14 – 18 years Time Limit 6 mins. \$10.00

15. Duologue 11 – 13 years Time Limit 4 mins. \$10.00

DRAMA CHAMPIONSHIP

Two Pieces to be performed. Time limit **TOTAL** for the performance of both pieces. Citation of Source must be provided.

16. Senior Drama Championship 14 – 18 years. Time Limit 6 mins. \$10.00

- (a) Shakespearean Recital
- (b) Contrasting Character Recital from a contrasting period of literature or theatrical style. (e.g. Greek, Contemporary, Georgian, Edwardian, Brechtian)

17. Junior Drama Championship 13 years & under. Time Limit 5.5 mins. \$10.00

- (a) Character Recital from a published play or monologue written and adapted from a novel and performed "in character" 3 minutes maximum.
- (b) An improvisation of 2.5 minutes the topic provided by the adjudicator.

COMPETITORS SHOULD AVOID THE USE OF WORDS AND MATERIAL THAT ARE NOT REGARDED AS ACCEPTABLE IN A FAMILY GROUP OR POLITE SOCIETY. CONTESTANTS USING "UNACCEPTABLE" WORDS COULD FACE DISQUALIFICATION.

Instructions for Direct Deposit

Caution: These instructions must be followed completely and accurately. Failure to complete ALL steps may jeopardise your money AND invalidate your entry into the eisteddfod.

1. Please complete your application from the appropriate section of the Schedule as you would if paying by cash or cheque.
2. You must complete a separate application for **EACH** section. You must **NOT** combine applications across sections. Each section has a different convenor with their own unique bank account.
3. Please complete all details required on Entry Form for the Section you wish to enter. Add cost of program/s if posting required and then enter the total for entry fees plus program/s. (Each program covers the whole of the Eisteddfod)
4. You will deposit this total via internet.
5. Log into your internet banking account and transfer the total from the above self-made invoice to the following bank details.

6. **IMPORTANT.** You **MUST** print the confirmation screen from your internet browser and include that printout with your application.
7. You **MUST** mail the Entry Form/Tax Invoice along with the direct deposit printout to the appropriate convenor to ensure that you are correctly enrolled.
8. Complete the above process for each section that you wish to enrol.
9. You must **NOT** combine direct deposits across several sections.
10. Failure to mail the correct printout of your direct deposit **TOGETHER** with your Entry Form to the correct section convenor will invalidate your application.
11. If you prefer, you can pay by Cash, Cheque or Money Order, but if you wish to pay by Internet Direct Deposit, you must complete every step above or your entry will not be accepted.
