To assist with being Covid safe please stay at home if unwell.

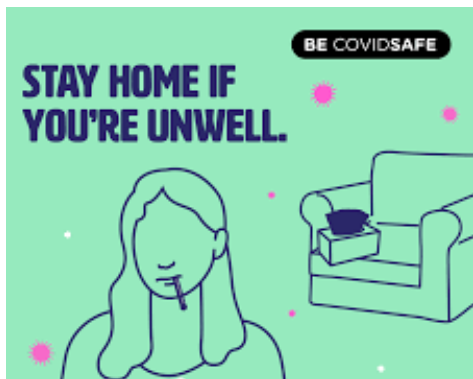

Catherine Broadstock

Catherine Guinevere Broadstock is an 'exciting and passionate' pianist who has been in demand for some twenty years for her ability to perform and accompany with accuracy and insightful musicianship.

She regularly performs for Opera Queensland, The Queensland Choir, Queensland Symphony Orchestra Chamber Concerts and for 4MBS Festival of Classics. She holds degrees from the University of Southern Queensland and the Queensland Conservatorium (Griffith University) and has studied piano with Kevin Power, Wendy Lorenz, Natasha Vlassenko, Oleg Stepanov and masterclasses with Cedric Tiberghien and Roger Woodward.

Catherine was a first prize winner of the Queensland Piano Competition and the Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University's Margaret Nickson Prize.

In 2005 Catherine was pianist with the Australian Youth Orchestra on their state tour and in 2006 was pianist with the Sydney Youth Orchestra on their tour of Spain and Portugal. In March 2007, Catherine and fellow pianist, Adam Gordon Herd, made their debut with the Queensland Symphony Orchestra performing Poulenc's Concerto for Two Pianos. Catherine has also performed as a soloist with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, and in such halls as the Roy Thomson Hall in Toronto and the Avery Fisher Hall at the Lincoln Centre in New York City. She has also toured Australia and New Zealand as a soloist and chamber pianist. In 2012 she released a CD of Haydn Sonatas and has recorded the piano music of Australian composer, Dr Graeme Wright Denniss for upcoming CD release.

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Julene Robertson Memorial Bursary.

Julene grew up on the Sunshine Coast and commenced her musical life having piano lessons with Mrs Patricia Maroney in Nambour. Mrs Maroney was a foundation member of the Sunshine Coast Junior Eisteddfod committee when the eisteddfod recommenced 56 years ago. She encouraged Julene to participate over the years in this event.

After obtaining her teaching degree in secondary classroom music Julene taught up north before returning to the coast and teaching at Maroochydore State High School for many years. While she was there, she continued to support the eisteddfod regularly entering small ensembles from her classes. Julene moved to New South Wales and taught in Sydney before once again returning to the coast and taking a position at Matthew Flinders Anglican College. Once again during her time at this school many of her students were involved in the Eisteddfod each year.

*Sadly, Julene passed away early in 2023 and her parents wished to offer a bursary in her memory. The bursary will be calculated on point-based aggregate between the **age solo** and the **championship** and awarded to the student with the highest mark.*

This bursary will be awarded on Saturday night at the conclusion of the championships.
